Founded in 1988 by the DeCaro family and Paul “Chip” Lord, Classic Envelope Inc. employs approximately 85 people at its 150,000 square foot facility located in Douglas, Massachusetts. In 2014, Classic generated approximately \$13 million USD in revenues from the sale of stock and custom envelopes and letterhead, primarily through various re-sale channels. Peter DeCaro, a third-generation envelope veteran, will continue to lead Classic Envelope Inc. and its team of skilled and talented individuals.

“We are excited to be joining the Supremex family at this time. Our values and business outlook are very similar, and with the resources of one of the largest and most financially stable envelope manufacturers in North America we are looking forward to growing the business that my family built,” added Peter DeCaro, General Manager, Classic Envelope.
